Parent/Caregiver Information

Arrival & Pickup Times: Children should not arrive before 8.50am and need to be collected by 3.10pm.

Sign In & Out Procedures: Your child must be signed in and out of the programme. We appreciate that this takes a few moments of your time, and thank you for your co-operation.

Access/Custody Arrangements: Please inform us if there are specific arrangements we need to know about.

Absentees: If your child is going to be absent you must call WestREAP on 03 755 8700 by 8.30am that morning to advise.

Refunds: Refunds will only be given if you contact WestREAP the Friday prior to when the programme commences.

Programme Policies & Procedures: We have a framework of operating policies and procedures. A copy of these will be available at the programme for your information.

Behaviour Management: We expect children to be responsible for their own behaviour. To ensure the programme environment is safe and pleasant for all, we have adopted a positive behaviour management plan. Disruptive behaviour, or behaviour that puts the child or others at risk is not acceptable, and the child's parent/caregiver may be asked to remove the child from the programme.

Suggestions & Complaints: We ask that you please complete the parental evaluation form. This is available from the programme supervisor.

Complaints: If you are unhappy with any aspect of the programme, a complaints procedure form is available from the programme supervisor, or discuss your concern with the programme co-ordinator.
