

WHAT DOES WESTREAP OFFER RANGATAHI?

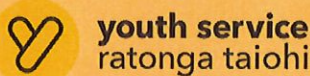
Our experienced Youth Coaches, Abbey & Rachel, work with groups of young people in the Westland and Grey Districts to support them to reach their goals.

For example, we coach young people with mental health, trauma, housing & truancy issues and those who have experienced drug & alcohol and/or domestic violence themselves or with their wider whanau/carers.

- Youth Payment – for those aged 16 & 17 who can't live with their parents/guardians.
- Young Parent Payment – for young people aged 16 to 19 who are the main caregiver for a child
- The NEET (Not in Education, Employment or Training) Service for 16- & 17-year-olds who are either not in education, employment or training or are at risk of leaving school early or without a clear next step.

DRIVER LICENSE HELEN- DRIVING INSTRUCTOR



We currently offer free Learner Licence classes, which includes the cost of the licence. This is an 8-hour session over two weeks. 100% attendance is required to get the test paid for. We have an i-endorsed Restricted Driving tutor, Helen, who can be booked for an hourly rate. We also work with Salvation Army to help facilitate restricted driving lessons for free.

NGĀ TOKI AKO – ALTERNATIVE EDUCATION

This programme is for those under 16 who are struggling in the mainstream education setting. Our facilitators support young people back into education, training or employment. We generally get referrals directly from high schools or the Ministry of Education.

MATES AND DATES



WESTLAND, GREY AND BULLER SCHOOLS

We currently have trained facilitators working in high schools on a 5-session programme to teach essential skills in having healthy relationships and preventing sexual and dating violence. The programme teaches communication skills and behaviours they can carry with them throughout their lives.

YOUTH PATHWAY INITIATIVE

JENNY- PATHWAYS ADVISOR

Jenny is our pathways advisor working to transition all students in Year 11 – 13 into further education, employment and training and to work with students in and out of school that require support and guidance to engage in education, employment and training.



Pita & Pascale are our facilitators bringing this programme into Westland schools.

These sessions involve personal goals, teamwork and a particular task, often using the environment outside of school, for example – a run up the hill towards the airport carrying stretchers with sandbags.

The value of Whare Tapawhā is integral to this programme.
